




Institut français de Birmanie

A DELF-B2 Diploma is generally required to study in France.





Official Diplomas awarded by the **French Ministry of Education** to certify proficiency in French as a foreign language. To achieve official diplomas, adults, teens, and children can take exams twice a year: at the end of **May** and the end of **November**.



REPUBLIQUE FRANC The DELF Junior/ Scholastic is intended for teenagers, foreigners or French, who wish to develop their skills in the French language.

Both DELF "Prim" and "Junior" versions imply that only the themes that interest the youngest are included in the exercises. This is because the DELF exams assess communication skills. A young learner will be placed in a context that will make it easier for him/her to react in the "Prim" or "Junior" version; he/she will thus be able to demonstrate all his/her skills to the evaluators.

The DELF diploma for the "Prim" and "Junior" versions have the same value as a diploma for the "General Public" version. The exam version is not indicated on the diploma.
